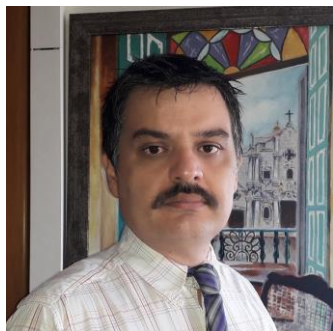


Dr. Georgios I. Farantos ShortBio
